## Washtenaw County

### Winter Tax Bill

#### County Parks

For Parks and Recreation purposes, including acquisition, maintenance, and operation of Park lands and Recreation facilities.

#### Natural Areas

For the purpose of purchasing Natural Areas in order to preserve them, paying the costs of operating a land preservation program and paying the costs of maintaining the land purchased.

#### EECS

To provide funding to improve the County Enhanced Emergency Communications System by constructing additional towers, upgrading the existing infrastructure and purchasing the necessary equipment.

#### Veteran's Relief

To be used for direct services for eligible indigent veterans and their dependents, including County Veteran Services employee staff time providing such services.

#### Act 88/Economic Development

To promote Agricultural, Industrial and Tourist advantages of Washtenaw County. It funds programs such as Ann Arbor SPARK, SPARK East, Eastern Leaders Group, activities in the Washtenaw County Department of Economic Development and Energy, MSU Extension, 4-H, 4-H Youth Show, Food Systems Economic Partnership, and used to promote Heritage Tourism in Washtenaw County.

#### HCMA

To fund Capital Improvements and Operations of the Huron-Clinton Metropolitan Authority, which administers a regional park district, the Huron-Clinton Metroparks. For example it includes Delhi Metropark, Hudson Mills Metropark, Dexter-Huron Metropark.

#### Roads

To keep any County roads, streets, bridges already built in reasonable repair, and in condition reasonably safe and fit for public travel.
