

Huron River Chain of Lakes Update

Just a quick update!

MDEQ Permit Status: The permits for each of the bodies of water of the HRCL have been submitted to the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality for review.

Portage-Baseline Lake Level: The lowering to the winter level began on November 30th. This date corresponds with when the boat launch closes for the season. Each winter the lake level is lowered to reduce ice and frost damage and erosion at the lake.

Looking Ahead: The year-end reports from the lake scientist, Dr. Pullman, will be added to the website as he completes them.

And Finally... Please continue to refrain from eating the fish caught in the HRCL! The PFAS related 'Do Not Eat' Fish consumption advisory is still in effect.
