**PROPOSAL A**

**CITY ORDINANCE INITIATIVE  
FOR PEACE IN CENTRAL AMERICA**

Shall the the City adopt an ordinance requiring: 1) the City Clerk to convey to the federal government a statement by the people of Ann Arbor expressing the desire that our tax dollars be spent on peaceful, not military, purposes in Central America, supporting the right of self-determination; and 2) the City to establish a Central America Sister City Task Force to facilitate educational, cultural, and peaceful exchanges.

The total number of votes cast was 16,812.

The number of YES votes cast was 10,336.

The number of NO votes cast was 6,476.

The proposal was passed by a margin of 3,860.

Shall the City of Ann Arbor, County of Washtenaw, Michigan, borrow the principal amount of not to exceed \$3,000,000 and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefore, for the purpose of acquiring and constructing improvements to streets and roads, together with all necessary appurtenances, in the City of Ann Arbor?

The total number of votes cast was 16,587.

The number of YES votes cast was 10,148.

The number of NO votes cast was 6,439.

The proposal was passed by a margin of 3,709.




