EEE informational meeting tonight at Webster Township Hall

Washtenaw County Administration, Washtenaw County Commissioner Sue Shink, and Washtenaw County Health Department are hosting a public meeting on Eastern Equine Encephalitis, or EEE, and the aerial mosquito spray slated for a small portion of Webster and Northfield Townships in northern Washtenaw County. Aerial spraying is being carried out in parts of the state with confirmed human or animal cases to decrease mosquitoes that can carry the potentially deadly virus. Officials will provide information, listen to concerns and answer questions.
