# COVID-19 Temporary Housing

Have COVID-19 or at risk for COVID-19 and need housing?

Washtenaw County Health Department has limited, temporary housing at local hotels for individuals with COVID-19 or those who have had close contact with someone with COVID-19. The purpose of this housing is to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in our community. The Health Department is providing shelter for individuals or families who are homeless or those who would put a family member at risk for COVID-19 if they returned home.

## **You may qualify if you:**

- Have COVID-19 and, if you returned home, you would put a family member at risk for COVID-19.
- Are homeless and have COVID-19 or are at-risk for COVID-19.

## **If you qualify for housing, you will be expected to:**

- Stay in your hotel room for the duration of your stay.
- You will be checked out when you are no longer at risk of being contagious.

## **Along with housing, the Health Department will provide:**

- Three meals a day.
- A thermometer.
- A mask.
- Personal care items such as toothpaste, soap, and feminine hygiene products, if needed.
- Clothing, if needed.
