



Homeless Under Other Federal Statutes – HUD Definition of Homeless Category 3 and At Risk of Homelessness

Both the Category 3 Definition of Homeless and the At Risk of Homelessness definition include households that are homeless under other federal statutes. The below list includes programs and services that households may be participating in if they qualify as homeless under other Federal statutes. Not all households receiving services through the below programs are doing so as a result of homeless status, so staff should be sure to ask if services are received due to homeless status.

Section 387 Runaway and Homeless Youth Act: Runaway and Homeless Youth Programs

- Basic Center Program (shelter): Ozone House
- Transitional Living Program/Miller House: Ozone House
- *Street Outreach Program: Ozone House*

Section 637 of the Head Start Act

- Education Project for Homeless Youth: WISD/Ozone House

Section 41404 of VAWA

- SafeHouse Center Programs

Section 330(h) of the Public Health Service Act

- Healthcare for the Homeless: Packard Health

Section 3 of the Food and Nutrition Act

- Food assistance programs through MDHHS

Section 17(b) of the Child Nutrition Act

- Free school meals

Section 725 of the McKinney Vento Homeless Assistance Act

- Education Project for Homeless Youth: WISD/Ozone House or other school services for homeless youth/children
