

Home COVID-19 Testing

What to Know

If you test positive with a rapid home test

- Start isolating yourself right away. Continue for at least 10 days.
- Tell your close contacts, so they can quarantine themselves.

Report your results, if you are positive

- Reporting is not required, but encouraged.
 - Tell your doctor or primary health care provider, if you have one.
 - Contact Washtenaw County Health Department at 734-544-6700 or email health@washtenaw.org. Let us know that you tested positive and provide a name and phone number where we can reach you.
 - If you use the Say Yes! COVID Test app, you can report your positive results using the app.
 - After the Health Department receives your results, a nurse or contact tracer will call you to follow up and answer any questions.

Frequent testing and contract tracing can help prevent or quickly control COVID-19 outbreaks.

Testing is recommended two times per week for unvaccinated people 8 years and older. Choose up to two unvaccinated members of your household to take part in the challenge, testing two times a week for a month or until all tests are used. Individuals with the highest risk of exposure to the COVID-19 are the best choice.
