**NOTICE OF EXCEEDING MAINTENANCE LIMIT**

The Recreation Park Subdivision Drain is a stormwater system under the jurisdiction of the Washtenaw County Water Resources Commissioner. Per the Michigan Drain Code, Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended, the Office of the Water Resources Commissioner is authorized to spend an annual amount of \$5,000 per mile of drain on maintenance. If that amount is exceeded, there is a statutory requirement to notify the property owners within the drainage district.

**The annual maintenance limit on the Recreation Park Subdivision Drain was exceeded by Emergency Order issued by the Washtenaw County Water Resources Commissioner. The emergency order was a result of a pipe failure that created a sink hole causing a street closure in the area of Taft Road and Lathers Road, and its subsequent repair.**

Pursuant to Section 196(6) of The Michigan Drain Code, Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended, please take notice that the expenditure amount on the Recreation Park Subdivision Drain exceeded the amount established under Section 196(4), and an assessment will be levied for the amount expended on the Recreation Park Subdivision Drain.
