Instructions for Completing Application for Request for Environmental Health Review of Addition / Change of Use

An application will only be accepted if complete and if it includes all required documentation as noted below. Please contact the Washtenaw County Environmental Health Division at 734-222-3800 with questions.

For all applications:

1. Check prior records and maps for helpful information about the property, and for assistance in creating a site plan.
 - **OnBase** - Previous site plans; well, septic, building inspection, and soil erosion permits. For best results, only enter the street # and click search: www.washtenaw.org/permitrecords
 - **MapWashtenaw** - Parcel maps and property data: www.washtenaw.org/mapwashtenaw
 - **Site Plan Tutorial** - Video showing how to use MapWashtenaw to create a site plan: <http://bit.ly/siteplanmap>
2. When submitting large or blueprint size plans (anything larger than 11"x17"), submit 2 copies of the plans to our office. For plans 11"x17" or smaller, submit 1 copy, as we can make additional copies in the office.
3. If a site visit is required, the property owner is responsible for locating and uncovering 2 diagonal corners of the drainfield if there is a sewage permit on file, or all 4 corners of the drainfield if there is no sewage permit on file. Check our online software, OnBase, at www.washtenaw.org/permitrecords for existing records. Our staff can also provide a copy of a prior site plan and permit if you do not have internet access.
4. The contractor or owner must contact MISS DIG at 811 or 800-482-7171 to have underground utilities marked before any digging starts.

- Completed application
- Application fee
- Township zoning approval or waiver
- Site plan showing location of addition and well/septic features*
- Floor plan showing existing & new features

Non-Residential Project Instructions

Submit the following:

- Completed application
- Application fee
- Township zoning approval or waiver
- Site plan showing location of operation and well/septic features*
- Narrative of the proposed construction/change of use

*Be sure to include ALL existing and proposed locations of any home, well, septic system, outbuilding, pool, fuel tank, and geothermal well/loop on the site plan.

Updates can be made to an existing site plan if one is on file with our office. Check our online permit database, OnBase, at www.washtenaw.org/permitrecords for existing records. If you do end up using an existing site plan that is on file with our office, please check the accuracy of the plan. Update the plan as needed with any new or different features before submitting to our office with this application.
