

The recall claims on this ballot are false. Election Law requires recall claims to be clear. Unfortunately, it does not require them to be true. The recall sponsors exploited this legal loophole to cast doubts on our elected officials in an attempt to overturn the 2004 election. This recall process has wasted County tax dollars, and is an injustice to our community.

I serve as Treasurer with integrity, safeguarding millions of public dollars. Township finances are excellent, despite a tight economy. The Supervisor, Clerk, and I work together, more than full time, managing all of Pittsfield's daily operations with experience and dedication. We freely give our own resources and overtime to the residents of Pittsfield.

Response to recall claims:

1. I do not set my salary. Our independent Compensation Commission set a 2.25% raise for 2006. I am not the highest paid Township Treasurer in Washtenaw County.
2. I truthfully stated on February 3, 2005 that I talked to the Township attorney regarding Wal-Mart. He has confirmed our discussions over several years. Public records prove this.
3. The Road Commission never urged us to change the site plan, and a letter from the Director states the approved layout is safest.
