Plans must be submitted with an Application for Plan Examination and the appropriate deposit before a permit can be issued, except as listed below. Plans are not required for the following: 1. One-and Two-Family dwellings containing not more than 3,500 square feet of building area. 2. Alterations and repair work determined by the plumbing official to be of a minor nature. 3. Buildings with a required fixture count less than 12. 4. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00. If the work being performed is described above, check below "Plans Not Required." Plans are required for all other building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to 1980 PA 299 and shall bear that architect's or engineer's seal and signature. <input type="checkbox"/> Plans not required

V. Homeowner Affidavit

ITEM #3 DOMESTIC WATER TREATMENT AND FILTER EQUIPMENT: A license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold-water distribution supply and associated water piping in buildings if a permit is secured, required inspections performed, and the installation complies with the applicable code. If the enforcing agency determines a violation exists, it shall be corrected by the responsible installer. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in item #3, number of drains (item #2), and the appropriate water distribution (system) pipe size fee.

ITEM #21 MOBILE HOME UNIT SITE: WHEN item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee plus the number of unit sites. WHEN setting a mobile home in a park, or a modular home on private property, a permit should include the application fee, a sewer or building drain, and a water service.

IX. Instructions for Completing Application

GENERAL: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with Washtenaw County Building Inspection. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Electrical Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected and approved.** The inspection telephone number will be provided on the permit form. When ready for inspection, call Washtenaw County Building Inspection providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspection department will need the **job address** and **permit number**.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing, and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.**
